Calendar of Events

Throughout the season, June to September, the village hosts a number of events, as do many of the surrounding villages just a few minutes drive distant. The Fêtes Patronales are lively and offer a little more entertainment for those who "like to move it, move it!!".

Saint Alyre Fête Patronale

The Fête Patronale is an interesting weekend. The village comes to life with an influx of visitors, families, and from local communes.

An all-night disco, a mediaeval procession, a torchlight parade, a funfair and fireworks display being just some of the entertainment

This is always held on the third Sunday in July, so covers the week leading up to weekend above.

Throughout August, the abbey town of La Chaise Dieu hosts a classic music festival which spreads out across the Haute Loire and Puy-de-Dome Departments. Top quality recitals and concerts take place in the Abbey (for which you need to purchase tickets in advance), and in many of the churches in adjacent towns and villages. Most are free to attend.

The "Rustival", Open Air Country, Rock and Jazz Music Festivals

In late summer, the Puy-de-Dome comes alive with music Festivals and visits to some of these can be arranged on request. The dates and schedules will be available in the spring of 2008.
